#### **Bike Education Program - Term 4**

We're excited to offer a **Bike Education program** this term for our students from **Wednesday 22 October to Wednesday 19 November 2025**.

The program is designed to:

- Build cycling confidence
- Develop safe riding skills
- Increase road safety awareness

Most sessions will take place on school grounds, with students gradually progressing to group rides on our local shared community trail. Some senior students may also have the opportunity to ride on quiet roads, under the supervision of a trained teacher, depending on their readiness.

Bikes and helmets can be stored securely at school for the duration of the program, or taken home each week if they can be returned before the next session. If your child doesn't have access to a bike or helmet, please let us know—we'll do our best to help source one.
