

## fun cooking fried rice

















#### Fried Rice



#### Ingredients

- 1 cup of white, long-grain rice
- 2 tsp vegetable oil
- 2 eggs, lightly whisked
- 2 bacon rashers, chopped
- 1 carrot, peeled and grated
- 2 spring onions, finely sliced
- ½ cup of frozen peas (defrosted)
- 1 tbsp soy sauce

#### Method

- 1. Cook the rice in a large saucepan of boiling water for 12 minutes or until tender.
- 2. Drain the rice and leave it to cool.
- 3. Heat oil in a non-stick wok or large frying pan over medium heat.
- Add <u>eggs</u> to the wok. Swirl over base to form an omelette. Cook for 2 minutes or until set. Transfer the omelette to a chopping board. Set aside to cool slightly. Cut the omelette into short strips.
- 5. Add bacon to wok. Cook for 4 minutes until light golden.
- 6. Add carrot. Stir fry 1 minute.
- 7. Add shallots , peas and rice. Cook, stirring, 3-4 minutes.
- 8. Add egg and soy sauce. Stir until heated through.
- 9. Serve immediately.
