#### **Storm Damage**

Thank you to everyone for your patience with the changes and interruptions this week. We still have a couple of outstanding tree clean ups to do, then some fence repairs, but hopefully our grounds are looking neat and tidy again soon. We will look to replace some of the trees in the grounds in the new year, planting in more suitable places or more suitable species for the spaces.
